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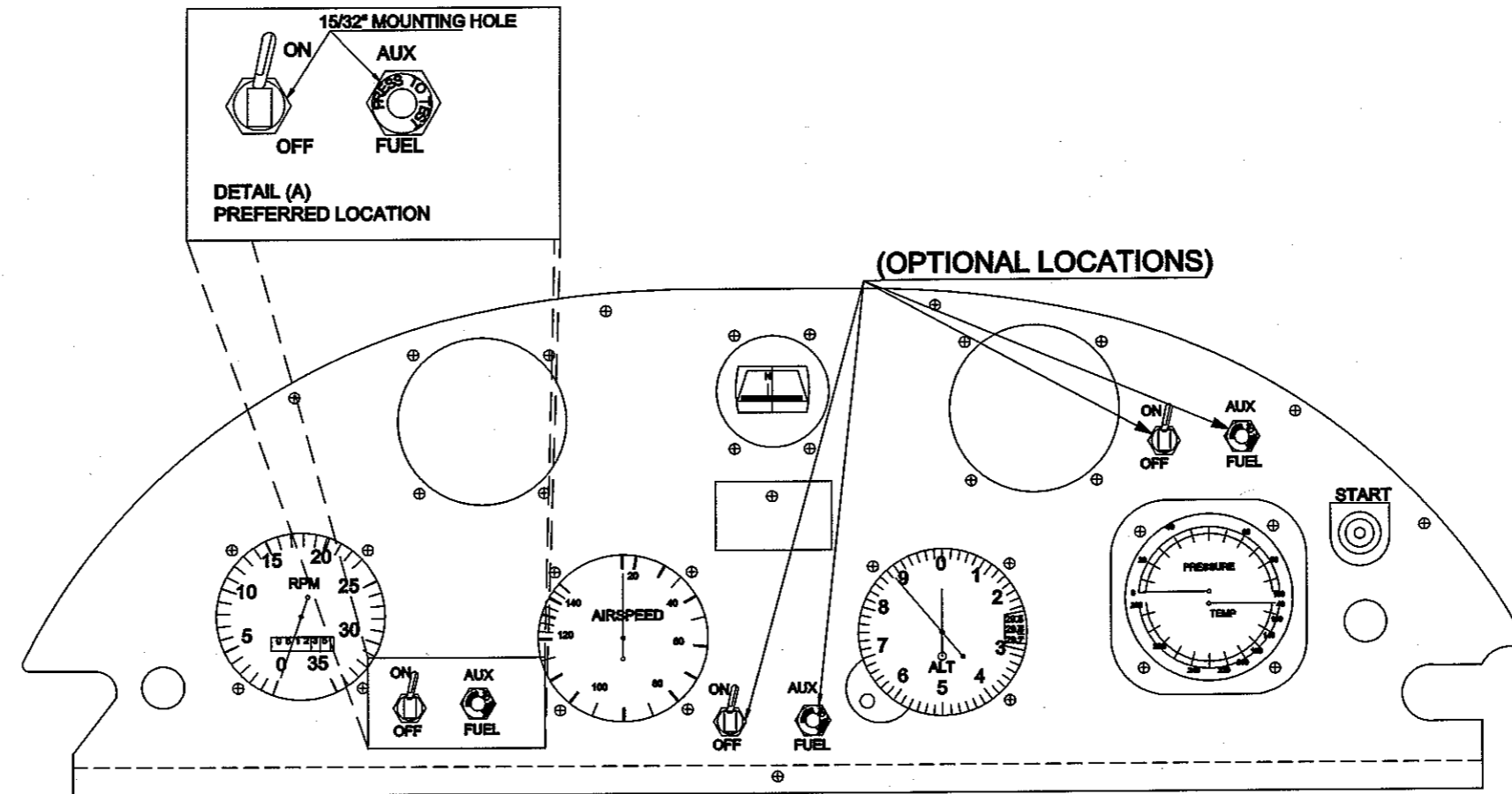

2. SWITCH AND ANNUNCIATOR TO BE LABELED WITH HIGH CONTRAST LETTERING SO AS TO BE VISIBLE UNDER ALL EXPECTED LIGHT CONDITIONS.
3. ADEQUATE LIGHTING MUST BE PROVIDED TO SWITCH AND PLACARD IF AIRCRAFT IS TO BE USED FOR NIGHT FLYING.
