

## **NOTES**

- 1. SWITCH AND ANNUNCIATOR LOCATIONS ARE NOT CRITICAL AS LONG AS BOTH ARE LOCATED ON INSTRUMENT PANEL AND IN PLAIN VIEW OF PILOT.
- 2. SWITCH AND ANNUNCIATOR TO BE LABELED WITH HIGH CONTRAST LETTERING SO AS TO BE VISIBLE UNDER ALL EXPECTED LIGHT CONDITIONS.
- 3. ADEQUATE LIGHTING MUST BE PROVIDED TO SWITCH AND PLACARD IF AIRCRAFT IS TO BE USED FOR NIGHT FLYING.
